After nearly two decades in the skin-care business working for pros like Brad Johns, Yasmine Djerradine, and New York's hometown dermatologist Dr. Zizmor, facialist **Shyou Hung** now works solo on a clientele of uptown devotees, models, and beauty editors. Offered on their own or with cleansing and mask, the anti-aging, firming, and lifting treatments utilize electric micro-current technology, light therapy, and microdermabrasion, while the basic acupressure facial focuses on deep cleaning (read: Extractions can hurt). **Customization is key to Hung's technique—she creates masks to suit each client's needs, and individualized attention dictates every part of the spa experience**—but the highlight of any facial is undoubtedly the heavenly accompanying full-body massage delivered by an assistant. Anti-cellulite ultrasound body treatments are also popular, and the salon sells a sampling of some of Hung's favorite products by lines like Jan Marini, Valmont and Hanna Isul. With its colorful tropical-flowered linens and the sweet scent of papaya lingering in the air, the single treatment room feels like a cabana in Bora Bora; be sure to check out the blue sky ceiling mural before closing your eyes. — Chrissy Persico

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
